## Instructions for Making Chatterbox

- 1. Cut out the square Chatterbox.
- 2. Fold and unfold the Chatterbox, along all four lines of symmetry. The creases will form a 'star' in the centre of the sheet.
- 3. Place Chatterbox on a flat surface, the blank side facing up. Fold each corner into the centre of the 'star'.
- 4. Turn the Chatterbox over. Fold each corner into the centre of the 'star'.
- 5. Fold the Chatterbox in half so facing outwards, are four square flaps.
- 6. Insert your thumbs and index fingers under the flaps. As you pinch your fingers together, the Chatterbox will take shape.
- 7. Now Colour, illustrate and personalise your chatterbox!

Several other sets of instructions can be found on the internet, including pictures, diagrams and movie clips, as well as written text.

## <u>Instructions for Using Chatterboxes</u>

There is no single 'set in stone' set of instructions, here is one suggestion.

- 1. Hold the Chatterbox and ask your partner to, 'select one of the four science words'.
- 2. Spell the word out aloud, opening/shutting the Chatterbox at the same time.
- 3. Ask your partner to 'select a number from 1-4 or 5-8' depending which half is open.
- 4. Repeat the counting process.
- 5. Ask your partner to 'select a number from 1-4 or 5-8' this time, read out the corresponding question.
- 6. The correct response is revealed by lifting the flap.
